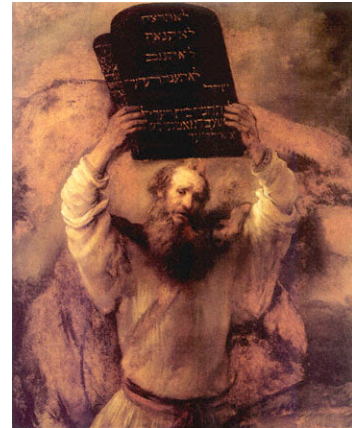


ANCIENT WORD, GOD'S WORD

Professor Tremper Longman III (BA, Ohio Wesleyan; MDiv, Westminster Seminary; PhD, Yale) is the Robert H. Gundry Professor of Biblical Studies at Westmont College in Santa Barbara, CA, and the author of over twenty books, including *How to Read Genesis* (InterVarsity) and *Literary Approaches to Biblical Interpretation* (Zondervan).

Professor Peter Enns (BA, Messiah; MDiv, Westminster; PhD, Harvard) is an in-demand scholar, writer, and speaker, who has taught at for 20 years at both the graduate & undergraduate levels. His 2005 work, *Inspiration & Incarnation* (Baker Academic), was written to help those struggling with questions such as these.
